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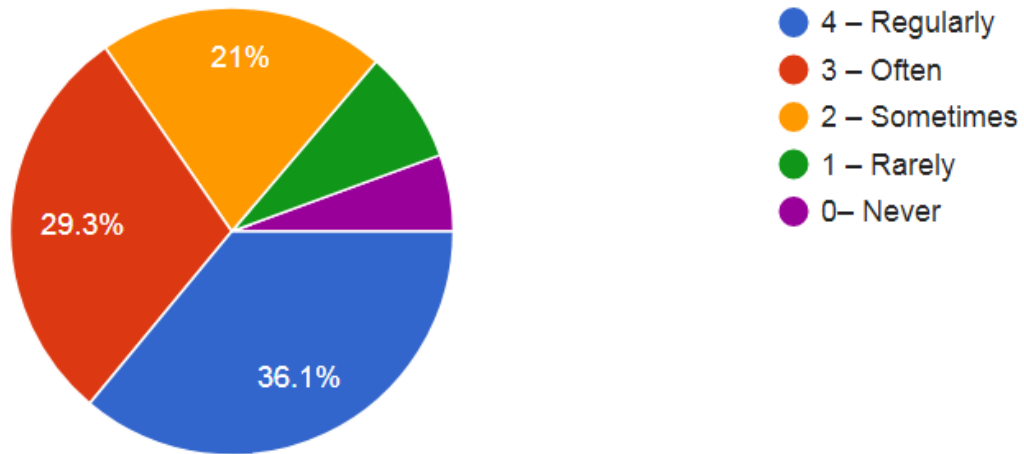
## **Student Satisfaction Survey**

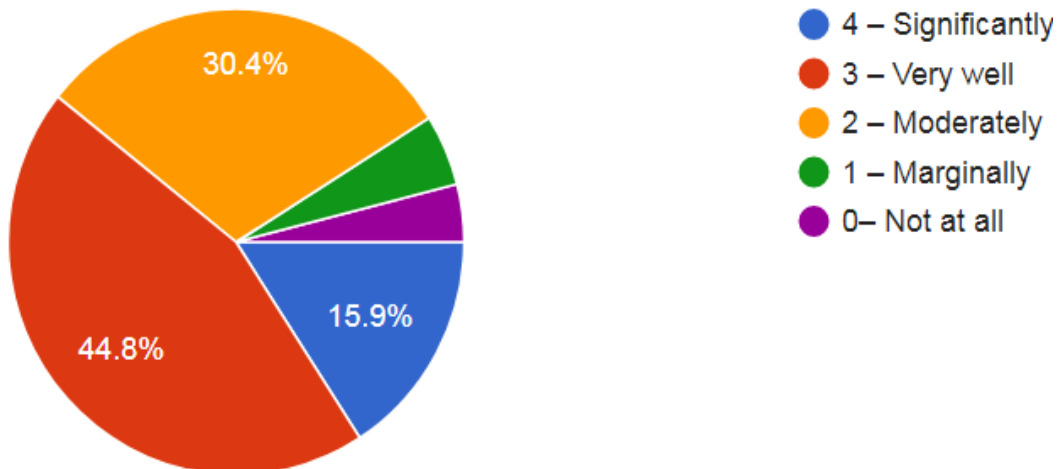
**1. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.**

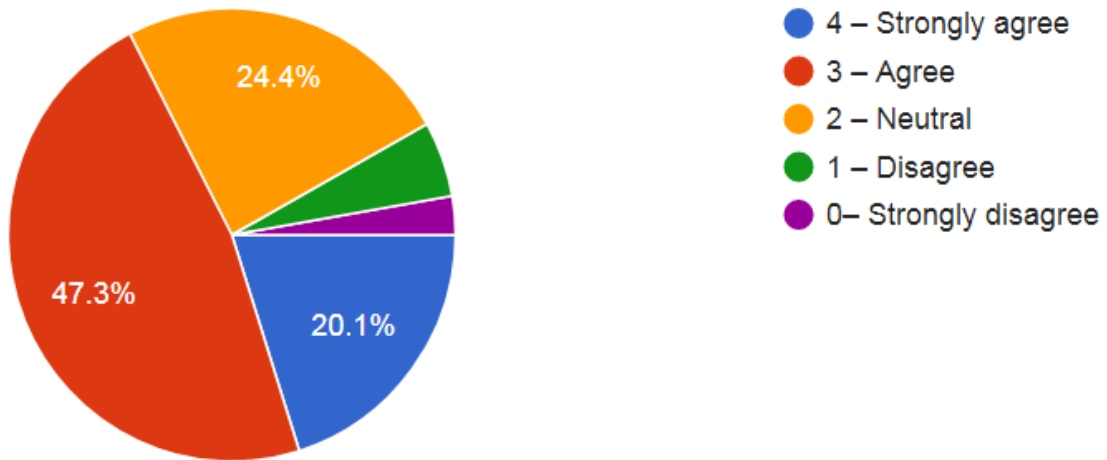
**2. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.**

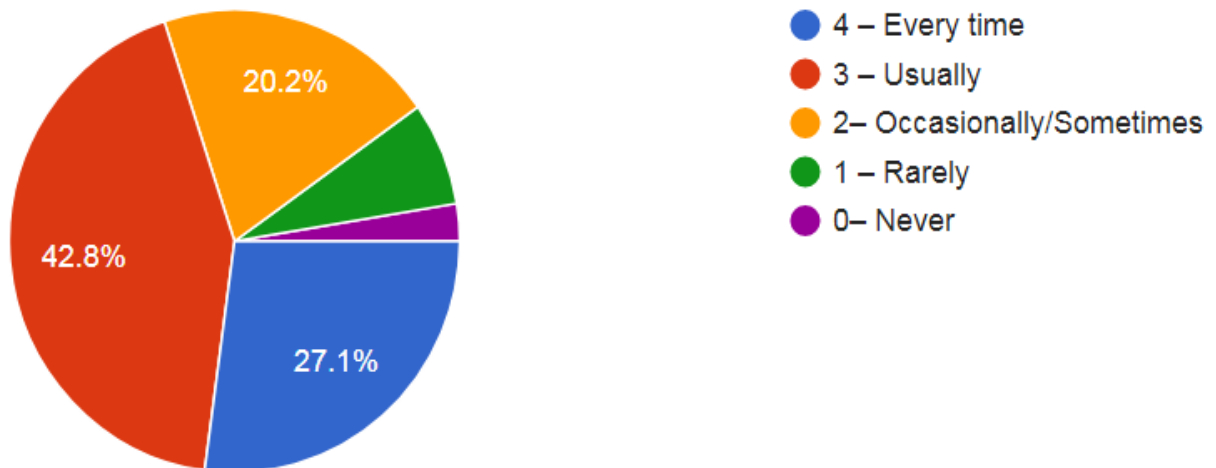
**3. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.**

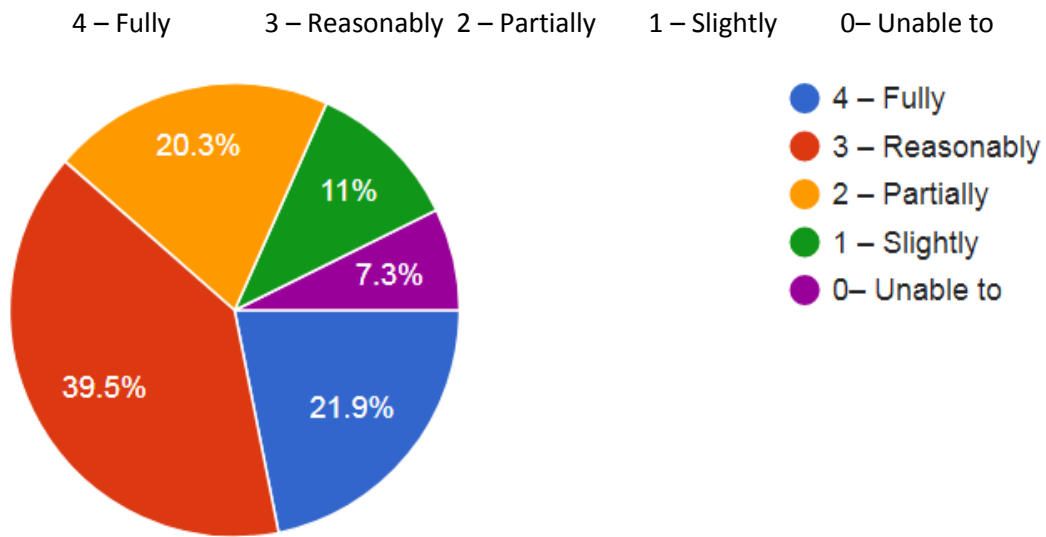


**4. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.**

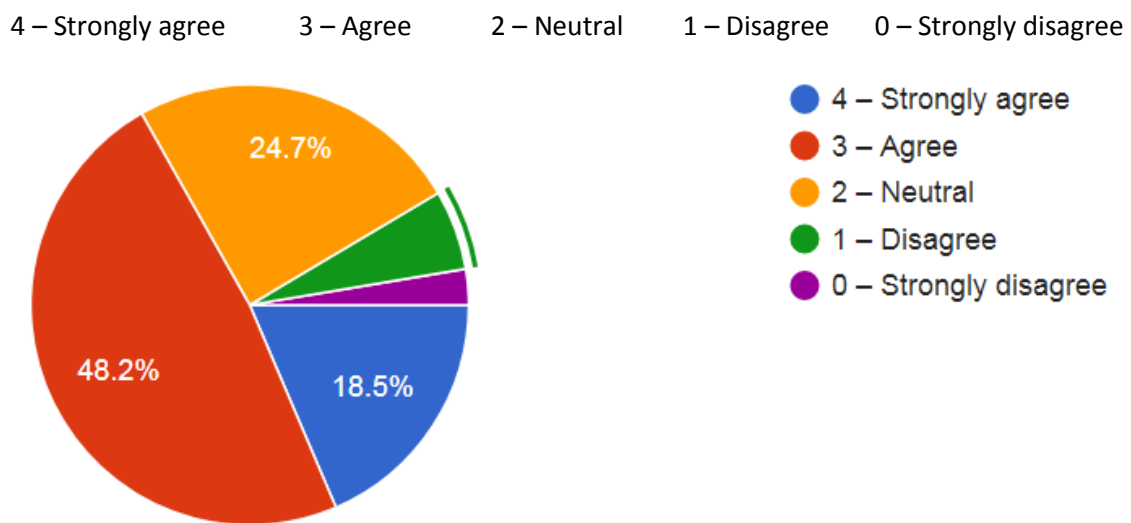

**5. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges**

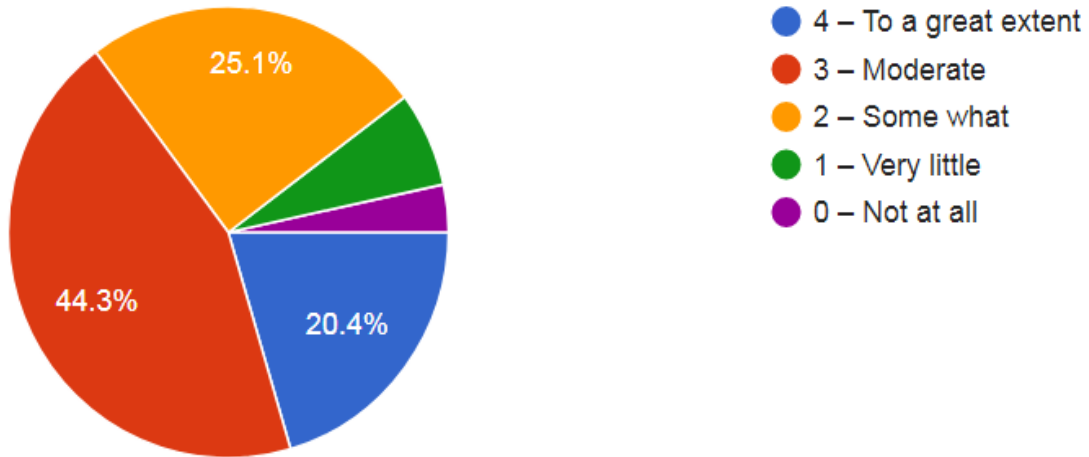


**6. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process**



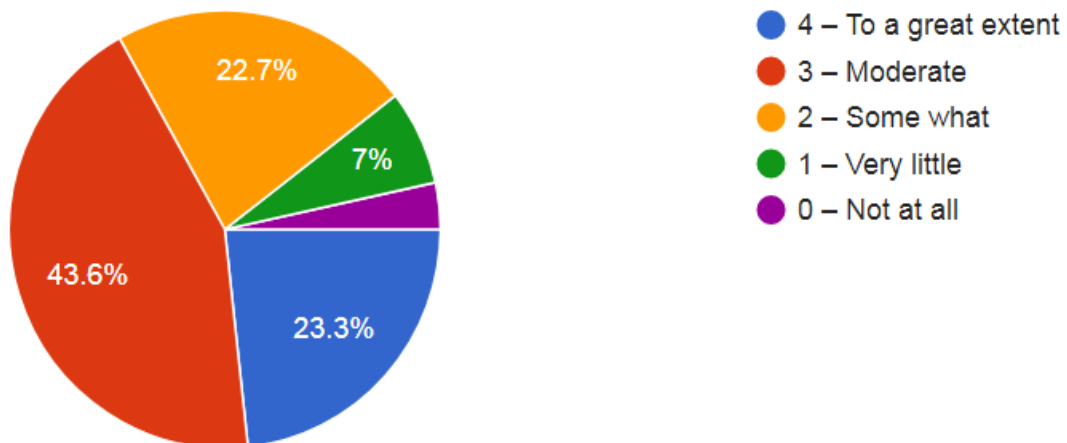
**7. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.**
