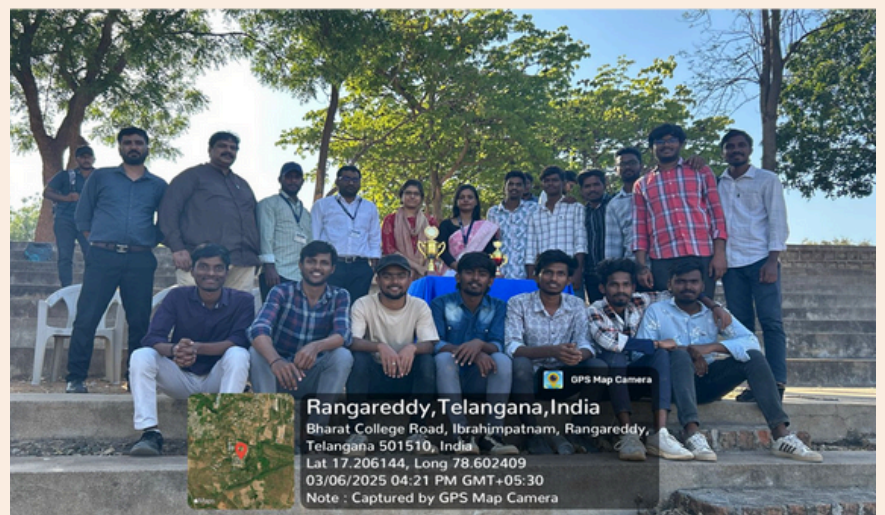


LANGUAGE MOSAIC INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

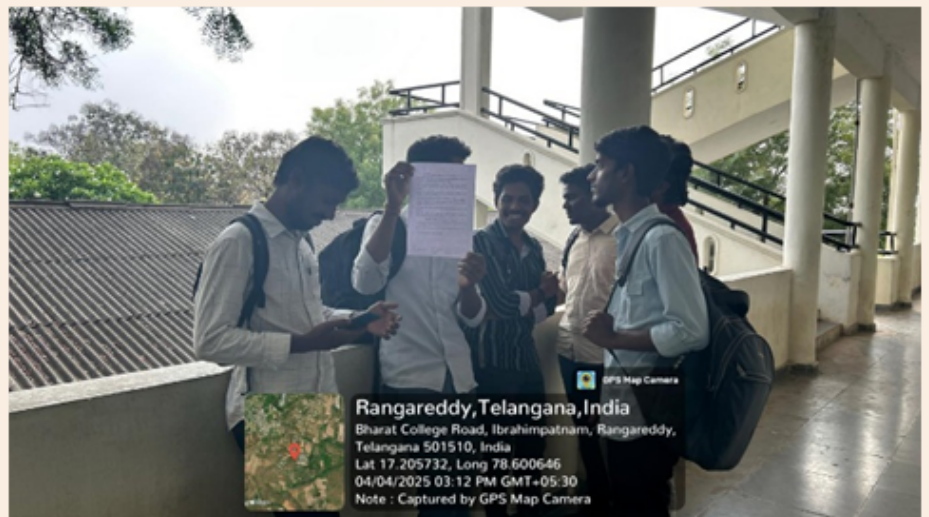
UGADI CELEBRATION

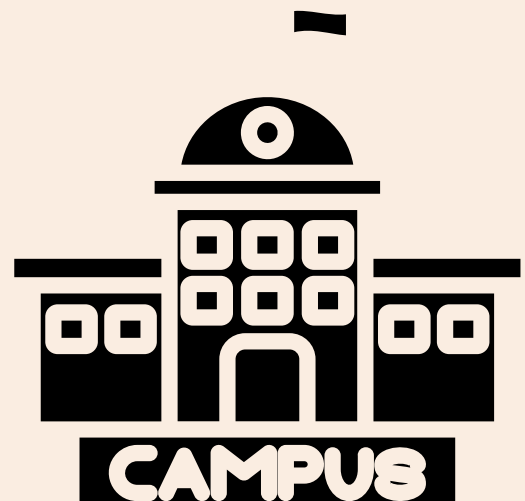
