Guest Lecture By Eminent Personality- Dr. Laxmi Mantha

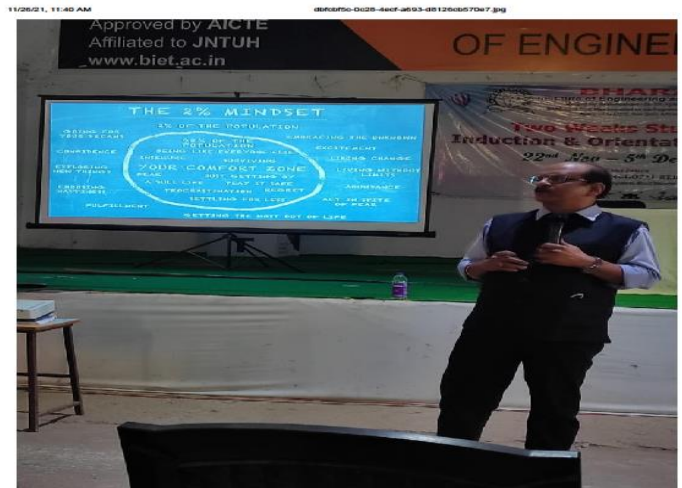
